How can I become a Miracle Mission Agent?

It's easy! Register and collect donations by setting up your online fundraising page or ask in person!

Who can be an Agent?

Anyone who would like to do something to help the patients at Children's Hospital.

Miracle Mission Agents are individuals or participants from businesses, departments within a company, schools, classes, churches, community groups and more.

How do I sign up?

You can register online at www.miraclemission.ca and set up a personal login and password. This gives you access to your personal web page, fundraising summary page and email.

Are there any materials to help me?

After you register online, we will send you a virtual toolkit to help you get started.

To help you collect donations in person and ask your contacts face to face, you can request a Miracle Mission kit during the online registration process.

Should I have a fundraising goal?

Setting a goal is a good idea. It gives you something to aim for, and it can help persuade the people you ask to give a little bit more. The amount you set as your goal is up to you.

How do I collect donations?

There are two easy ways to collect donations - by email for online donations and in person for cash or cheques. You can do one or both - whichever works best for you. Remember that some people can't say no to you in person, and some people are happy to give online. Experience shows that people give more when donating online.

Can people get a tax receipt for their donation?

Yes! If people give to you in person and they want a tax receipt, fill in the pledge form and send it in with the donation, and we will mail a tax receipt. You can find the pledge form in the Toolkit section of the website.

When should I collect donations?

Start NOW! You can collect whenever works best for you; Miracle Mission runs all year long, with an official wrap-up at Corus Radiothon for Children's on Friday, February 8, 2019.

What should I do with the money I collect?

Miracle Mission wraps up on Friday, February 8, 2019. Please drop off your donations at the Atrium, Children's Hospital, 800 Commissioners Rd E, London, Ont. between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m., or anytime at Children's Health Foundation's main office - 345 Westminster Ave., London, Ont.
