### Please read before donating...

Please adhere to the guidelines below when donating to the 2022 Holiday Toy Drive:

To drop off toys at Children's Health Foundation in person, please schedule a drop-off time <a href="here.">here.</a> Specific instructions for delivery will be provided upon scheduling a time slot.

- All items must be brand new and unwrapped.
- Note that anything received after December 16, 2022, will not make it over to the hospital for the holiday season.
- Donations received after December 16 will be delivered to the hospital in the new year.
- Toys will be accepted up until December 23 at 12 p.m.

Donation guidelines must be strictly enforced due to infection control policies, allergies, compromised immune systems, safety precautions and limited space.

We can only accept donations listed in **this document** and all donations **must be new and recently purchased.** 

We will not accept used toys, stuffed animals, fragile toys with small/sharp edges, violent toys such as guns, items with latex, scented products, food/candy, large ride-on vehicles or sports equipment. No items with corporate branding.

### How are donations distributed?

Your donations will be distributed to our patients at Children's Hospital throughout the year. They are given to patients and their siblings upon admission/discharge, during the holiday season, to acknowledge birthdays, celebrations, and used in waiting areas and playrooms.

### **Holiday Wrapping Donations**

Donations during the holiday season will be used as presents for all children who are in the hospital in both inpatient and outpatient settings.

Large sized holiday-themed bags, tissue paper and ribbon are needed to wrap the gifts. Bags must be new, unused and empty upon arrival. Wrapping paper and wrapped gifts will not be accepted.
