At Devereux, the individuals we serve and their families bravely tackle life on the “disability” spectrum every day. Their courage and resolve never wane. Through their successes, we see the term “diverse ability” as more reflective of our individuals, who, in partnership with families and communities, are actively leading engaged lives of purpose.

It is to honor that purpose that Devereux’s approach to care embraces differences and emphasizes creative and positive pathways to success. We combine an evidence-based treatment philosophy with the compassion that has been at our core for more than a century.

Adherence to the highest standards of care, a unique focus on engaging the entire family, and a strong business model carried us not just successfully, but strategically, through the last few very difficult financial years. Devereux has emerged from the Great Recession stronger and more secure than at any time in our history, and this has allowed us to chart a somewhat aggressive path for the next decade – designed to ensure Devereux remains the premier, and becomes the most readily accessible, provider of behavioral health services in the country. Our ability to forge new paths across the behavioral health landscape has allowed us to meet difficult challenges in rapidly changing environments, and that flexibility may never be more critical than it is at this moment.

Devereux is in a unique position to grow our existing programs and to expand to new markets and populations in need of our care. We see more exciting opportunities than at any time in recent history, and we are positioned to grow our signature programs and explore the most promising market opportunities.

Throughout fiscal year 2014, Devereux continued to expand our clinical excellence, invested in new technologies to facilitate organizational knowledge, and continued to meet or exceed our quality and

operational goals. Enhanced family collaboration and communications, a Devereux strategic plan priority, was emphasized throughout every facet of treatment. These accomplishments, coupled with forward-looking investments in staff training and responsible expense management, produced one of Devereux’s strongest years ever.

Our position in the behavioral health marketplace is certainly something of which the entire Devereux family should be proud. However, as our redoubtable Chairman of the Board Emeritus, Weaver Falberg, cautioned us many years ago, “Devereux must always sit in the noble seat of discontent.”

We may, in fact, be the most stable, well-capitalized provider of behavioral healthcare in the nation, but our work is never done. For individuals and families in need, for our loyal and outstanding staff, in support of our legacy of excellence, we must continue to aggressively pave the path forward.

Every day, Devereux professionals help change lives. Here are but a very few of Devereux's accomplishments in FY 2014:

Devereux Arizona's Research, Education & Advocacy for Children's Health (REACH) Conference focusing on children's mental health, education and advocacy was a tremendous success. Devereux mental health experts presented to a sold out audience on a variety of topics such as brain development, early childhood resilience-building strategies, treatments for disruptive behavior disorders, and Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (PBIS) for at-risk children. The REACH conference provides Devereux with a national model of excellence on behavioral health professional education.

In Devereux Pennsylvania, innovative studies are underway such as the Dialectical Behavior Therapy (DBT) program for adolescents in an outpatient setting. Key outcome areas include decreased instances of suicidal ideation, psychiatric hospitalization, treatment dropout, substance abuse, and interpersonal difficulties. As is the practice in Devereux, the ultimate goal is to replicate this protocol across Devereux programs where DBT can make a positive difference.

Devereux Florida was awarded the new Community Based Care contract serving the Department of Children and Families Southeastern Region, a significant geographic and programmatic expansion that includes Martin, St. Lucie, Indian River and Okeechobee Counties.

In Devereux New Jersey, new group home programs with specialized protocols to provide therapeutic opportunities for medically fragile individuals have been added to their already successful Project Freedom. These services were developed to fill a need when the state of New Jersey closed its state developmental centers. Devereux New Jersey's strong community services now also include in-home provision of Applied Behavior Analysis (ABA), respite and social services for the state.

In Devereux Massachusetts, Tannerhill, a Rhode Island social services organization, was acquired by Devereux Massachusetts. Their Therapeutic Foster Care (TFC) program will add to Devereux's existing array of services to make Devereux Massachusetts one of the largest providers of TFC and related services in the region.

Devereux Autism Summit 2014 was a national Devereux initiative for Devereux autism experts, clinicians and managers to host a discussion and learning forum for activities surrounding Autism Spectrum Disorder treatments, research and the latest findings in the field. Devereux speakers gave presentations and expert speakers from around the country also presented on specific topic areas of interest. Devereux's presence as a significant provider of services for individuals on the spectrum continues to gain momentum through its quality services and applied research collaborations with leading experts around the country.

Devereux Georgia's expert on the treatment of Commercially and Sexually Exploited Children (CSEC) Yolanda Graham MD, and Devereux's Senior Vice President of Clinical and Professional Affairs, Marilyn Benoit MD continue to lead efforts throughout Devereux to provide specialized treatment for children who have been commercially sexually exploited. Each year, as many as 300,000 children become victims of commercial sexual exploitation in the United States. Devereux's programs promote education, identity development, medical and psychiatric risk factors, healthy relationships, and relapse-prevention. Devereux Florida and Devereux Georgia and other Devereux centers are providing increasingly extensive services for children in need of such services.

Telehealth innovations expanding in Devereux: Devereux is ramping up telehealth services in select centers from Florida to Massachusetts and beyond. Telehealth services such as family therapy, wrap-around and autism specific services are becoming increasingly more prevalent at Devereux Centers across the country. Telehealth is helping to bring Devereux's services to individuals in need regardless of geography or time impediments.

Devereux Center for Effective Schools partners with the Philadelphia School District and International Institute for Restorative Practices to Improve School Climate. A \$730,676, multi-year grant from The Philadelphia Foundation's Fund for Children will fund the development of a comprehensive strategy aimed at changing the threat of violence. Devereux will provide training and technical support to implement and sustain a School-wide Positive Behavioral Interventions and Supports (SWPBIS) approach within ten K-8 schools. The program has received national focus at several large national symposia.

Devereux Clinical Excellence: Our own Marilyn Benoit MD, Senior Vice President of Clinical and Professional Affairs, Chief Medical and Clinical Officer, received the prestigious 2014 Virginia Q. Anthony Outstanding Woman Leader Award from American Academy of Child & Adolescent Psychiatry. The award celebrates the lifetime achievements of extraordinary women in the field of child and adolescent psychiatry. This esteemed award is for a woman who has applied her talent, medical skills, and leadership to dramatically improve the wellbeing of children with mental illness.

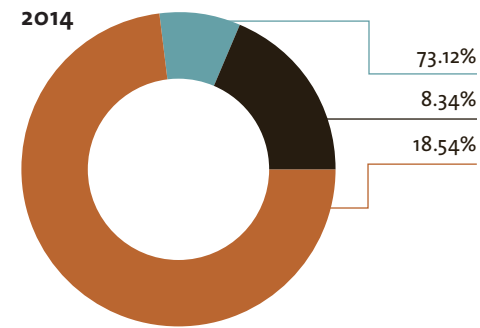
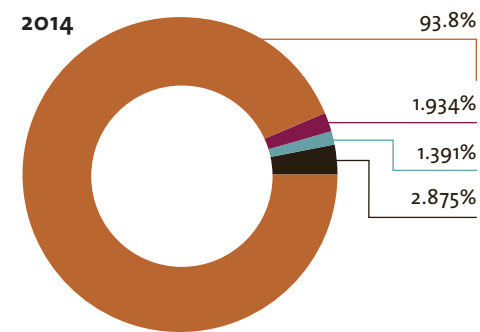

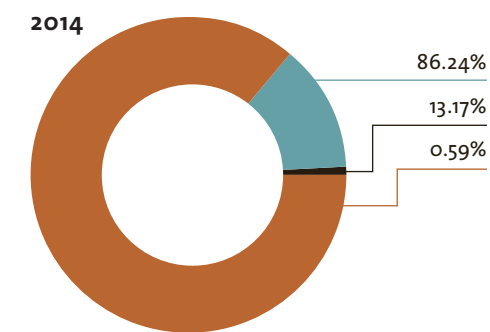
