Teachers, Parents, and Students-Together for Success

Strategy #1:

Teachers will provide reading materials/resources for the student to read aloud to parent/guardian.

Strategy/activity #2:

Teachers will provide key vocabulary words from preselected text for student to gain meaning and understanding.

Strategy/activity #3:

The teacher will provide student opportunities to select a leveled questioning assignment to complete at home.

Devereux Ackerman Academy Families

Strategy #1:

Parent/guardian and student will practice reading aloud for 15 minutes at least 2 times per week.

Strategies/activities #2:

The parent/guardian will utilize pre-selected vocabulary words to work with child to use in context in daily life at least 2 times per week.

Srategies/activities #3:

The parent/guardian will support student learning by reading and reviewing assignment together. For example: using guided reading or questioning technique. To be done twice weekly.

Devereux Ackerman Academy Students

Strategy #1:

Student will select reading material/resource and read independently for 10 minutes and then to parent/guardian, at least 2 times per week.

Strategies/activities with family members #2:

The student will practice using pre-selected vocabulary words making real world connection at least 2 times per week.

Strategies/activities with family members #3:

The student will complete reading assignment independently at least once per week. Asking for assistance when needed.
