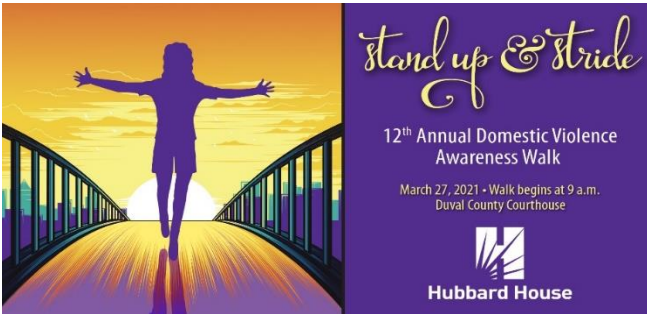

### Stand Up & Stride, 12<sup>th</sup> Annual Domestic Violence Awareness Walk Health and Safety Protocols, and Event Details



We are back in person, live at the Duval County Courthouse! (And we'll do everything in our power to safely host the event in-person. If we don't believe we can host safely, we'll go virtual!)

\*This is the first live event we've hosted in more than a year! \*

Due to the world we live in today, please read the following guidelines.

Face masks will be required for all participants, volunteers and spectators.

- Everyone at the courthouse, two years old and older, is required to wear masks and practice social distancing while on the courthouse grounds and on Adams Street, by the Start Line.
- Participants can remove their mask once they are walking and socially distanced on the route, though continual mask wearing is appreciated and increases the comfort for many members of our community.
- Staff and volunteers are always required to wear masks, on and near the courthouse grounds, near the Start/Finish Line, and on the route.
- There will be several sanitation options available at the event, on the Duval Courthouse Grounds.
- If you suspect or know that you've been exposed to COVID-19, are awaiting COVID-19 test results, have recently tested positive for COVID-19, or if you're experience COVID-19 symptoms or are feeling ill, please don't come to the walk. Stay home. Get well soon. We'll see you next year!

#### Registration & Pre-Event Shirt Pick-Up

- There will be NO day of event registration or t-shirt pickup.
- Event registration and donations will be handled online only. Please complete your business at [www.HubbardHouseWalk.com](http://www.HubbardHouseWalk.com). Online registration close March 24 at 11:59pm.
- T-shirt pickup – earned through fundraising or for purchase – will be available on March 26 from 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. outside the Hubbard House Thrift Store, 6629 Beach Boulevard, Jacksonville, FL 32216. (More details below.)
- If you suspect or know that you've been exposed to COVID-19, are awaiting COVID-19 test results, have recently tested positive for COVID-19, or if you're experience COVID-19 symptoms or are feeling ill, please don't come to the t-shirt pick-up. Stay home. Get well soon. We'll see you next year!

- The top individual and team fundraisers will also get a congratulatory shout-out at the start line.

### **Refreshments**

- While supplies last, there will be bottled water and snack items available on the courthouse grounds. A much more limited supply of water will be available on the route. To ensure you have what you need, you are welcome to bring a filled water bottle with you from home, to the event and carry it on the route. There will not be any water fountains or refill stations.
- Volunteers distributing the water and snacks will wear masks and gloves. When interacting with volunteers on the route, please wear a mask.

### **Start Line**

- The walk will start in three waves, 5 minutes apart, beginning at 9:00 a.m. This will allow for more social distancing and less bottlenecking on the route. Please follow the signage and gather and start with your wave on Adams Street, between Pearl and Clay.
- You will be assigned a registration number when you register online. Your registration number will determine your wave. Please be sure to have your registration number with you when you come to the event, so you know which wave you are assigned to. We will not have this information available at the event.
- Families and team members are encouraged to register on the same day, in quick succession. This will increase the probability that they will be assigned to leave in the same wave. (The event website, [www.HubbardHouseWalk.com](http://www.HubbardHouseWalk.com), allows participants to register other participants walking with you.)
- Once you register, find your wave assignment below.
  - Wave A is registration numbers 1-433
  - Wave B is registration numbers 434-867
  - Wave C is 868+
- Waves are filling up fast so register early.

### **Course**

- Medical personnel and police officers will be located on the course.

### **IMPORTANT INFORMATION ABOUT WALK REGISTRATION AND PRE-EVENT SHIRT PICK-UP**

Registration must be done online. There will be no registration available at the event.

### **Pre-Event Shirt Pick-up**

All personnel handing out t-shirts will wear gloves and mask. You must wear a mask while interacting with staff and volunteers.

Pre-event shirt pick-up is encouraged as they will not be available at the event. Note, if you earn a shirt, and fail to pick it up, there is not a guarantee you will receive one.
