



Achievement and Team Goal Posters

How-to-Use Guide

1. Hang the Achievement and Team Goal Posters side-by-side in your gym or classroom before Kick-Off Day.
2. Use the **Team Goal Poster** to track your team's progress so that all of your Team Member Champions can be motivated and inspired by their collective efforts.
3. Use the **Achievement Poster for Team Member Champions** in one of the following ways when they raise an amount of your choosing:
 - a. Your Team Member Champions get to sign the Achievement Poster when they have raised their **first** \$5, \$10 or whatever amount you decide will be the level – each Team Member Champion having the opportunity to sign the poster one time; OR
 - b. Your Team Member Champions get to sign the Achievement Poster for **every** \$5, \$10 or whatever amount you decide will be the level – each Team Member Champion having the opportunity to sign the poster multiple times.

You decide which option will inspire your students to raise the most funds for new PE equipment for your school (and a charity of your choice if you choose Pay it Forward).

You can also tie the instances they get to sign the poster to an incentive such as the students choosing or leading the PE activity for the day.

Allowing your students to sign the poster daily as they are raising health. moves. minds. funds will give them pride in their achievement as they work together towards the health. moves. minds. Team Goal.



Achievement Certificates

How-to-Use Guide

1. At the completion of your health. moves. minds. fundraising event, recognize individual student achievement and whole classroom achievement by presenting these achievement certificates, which can be customized.
2. Use the **Team Member Champion Achievement Certificate** in one of the following ways:
 - a. Present **EACH** of your participating Team Member Champions with an Achievement Certificate. Use the fillable form to insert the amount the student raised, their name and the date the certificate is presented; OR
 - b. Present participating Team Member Champions with an Achievement Certificate **if they raise a certain amount of funds (you decide the level)**. Use the fillable form to insert the amount raised by the student, their name and the date the certificate is presented.
3. Use the **Team Member Champion Top Fundraiser Achievement Certificate** to recognize the school's top individual fundraiser during your health. moves. minds. event.
 - a. Use the fillable form to insert the amount raised by the student, their name and the date the certificate is presented.
4. Use the **Classroom Challenge Winner Achievement Certificate** to recognize the top fundraising classroom during your health. moves. minds. event.
 - a. Use the fillable form to insert the amount raised by all students in the winning class, the name and grade level of the classroom and the date the certificate is presented.

Recognizing your students for their hard work, collaboration as a Team, and kind acts during your health. moves. minds. fundraising event will give them pride in their achievement.
