Franciscan CARE Plus includes the following services:

- Coordinating transitions of care from the hospital or a care facility to your home
- Assistance with navigating the healthcare system, advocacy on your behalf, and coordination of your care with your healthcare providers
- Disease process education to assist in long term care planning
- Advance Health Care Directives to allow your family to know and follow your wishes
- Caregiver education, training and support
- Assistance with applications for Medicaid services
- Assessments for language, cognitive or literacy barriers that may impede decision making or problem solving
- Initiating and completing referrals for in-home community services (bathing, home-delivered meals, transportation etc.)
- Assistance with placement in care facilities
